Personal Equipment counselors should come dressed & equipped to spend the day on land (pack, hiking stick, etc.). Personal needs may include: proper footwear, sunscreen, brimmed hat, sunglasses, lunch and/or snack, etc. Counselors should be prepared to take notes during program development.

Special Requirements

Development of custom programs requires that we set aside extra time and come prepared to analyze the local resources that support the chosen topic. Advance notice of interest in such programs required in order to provide for successful programs.
